Grounds of Appeal

Appellant stated that information provided by MLO (SWZ-II) was incomplete.

Decision

As r:gards question no. 1 & 2, Dy. Commissioner (Ops) stated that CMV Act and Rules made there under do not prohibit visually handicapped person (with normal vision in one eye) from getting driving license, but he is required to furnish Medical Certificate as prescribed in Form 1A of CMV Act.

As regards question no. 3, Dy. Commissioner (Ops) informed that documents required for Learner Driving License are mentioned in Rule 10 and for Driving License; these are mentioned in Rule
